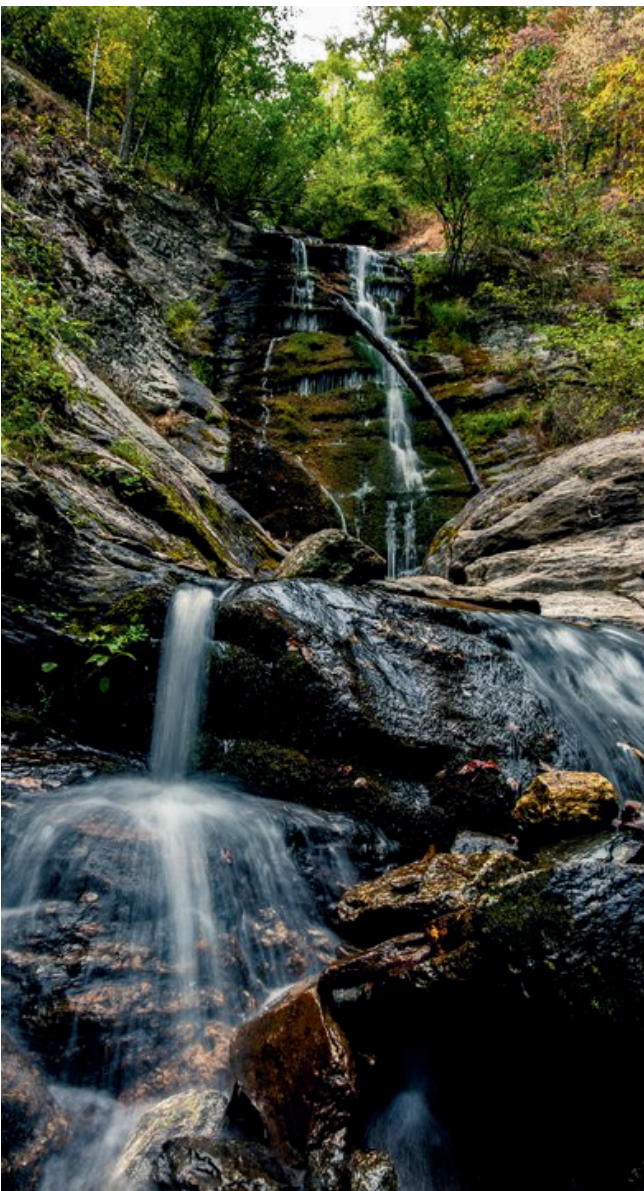




TOM'S CREEK FALLS

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Tom's Creek Falls is a serene, easy-to-access destination perfect for a relaxing nature outing. A gently, 100-foot multi-cascading waterfalls set in the picturesque Pisgah National Forest.



HIKING TRAIL

This easy, 1.25-mile round-trip loop is ideal for families with small children and those looking for a less strenuous hike. When the trail forks, follow the path to the left along the creek to reach the falls. It's a wonderful spot to enjoy the mist and the beauty of the surrounding forest

HISTORIC MILL FOUNDATIONS

As you reach the base of the falls, you can explore the remnants of the old stone mill. These historic foundations add a touch of mystery and intrigue to the landscape, offering a unique glimpse into the area's past right alongside the tranquil, multi-tiered cascades.

DIRECTIONS

From US 221 N., turn left onto Huskins Branch Road, just before the Woodlawn Motel. Travel approximately 1.3 miles to find the parking lot on the right (look for the gravel lot with a kiosk). The trailhead begins right at the lot.
